Qualifications for **PATH-WAY's** \$1000 SCHOLARSHIP:

Scholarship recipients must have a physical disability, which may include but not limited to: Neuromuscular Disorders or Musculoskeletal impairments such as Cerebral Palsy, Muscular Dystrophy, SMA, Dystonia, Osteogenesis Imperfecta, spinal cord injury, amputee.

Scholarship recipients are selected without regard to race, color, creed, religion, gender, age, or national origin.

Recipients are chosen based on the following considerations:

- Educational and career goals
- Leadership roles and participation in school or the community
- Management of disability in educational setting
- Academic Record
- Financial and family circumstances

Scholarship applicants must be a permanent resident of MA or NH and a high school graduate/graduating 2020 who is seeking a post-secondary education.

- Applicants must <u>complete the application</u> and mail to the address shown on the form along with the written essay described below.
- Applicants must submit a written, personal profile explaining the nature of their disability, their career goals and aspirations.
- Applicants may describe any financial needs as well as any pertinent personal/family circumstances they wish to disclose.
- Applicants must have their school send original transcripts to the address shown on the application form and include a letter of recommendation.
